The Washington DC Chapter is one of 42 chapters in 17 states plus Bermuda. Our 63 year old organization has: (1) planned and conducted yearly programs for local school children in the areas of Health, Education, Employment, Recreation plus Arts and Humanities; and (2) provided hundreds of scholarships to local high school graduates. The WDC Chapter has also funded and provided camp sponsorships, scholars mentoring and tutorials.

Since Jubilee 2016, Washington, D. C. Continentals have served almost 6000 school-age children in Health, Education, Recreation, Employment plus Arts/Humanities and attributed up to 900 volunteer hours.

Health: Dental screenings, Heart awareness, Anti-drug awareness – 809 students

Education: Public speaking, Reading tutorials, Book donations – 3,990 students.

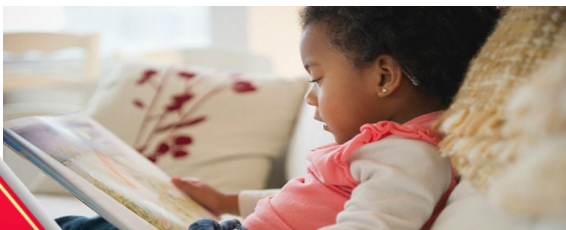
Employment: Financial and Resume Workshops and Film viewing 25 – students.
